NM documentary filmmaker David Garcia tells the story of three grief-stricken mothers seeking solace and hope on the waters of one of America's last wild rivers. Four years and multiple river trips in the making, "Hearts on the Gila" is a lush cinematic river-level journey down one of America's great natural treasures. As the film nears completion, the filmmaker is taking a work-in-progress cut of the film on the road to share with select Southwestern communities that have a stake in the future of the threatened Gila River.
